

## **LEGAL NOTICE**

### **VILLAGE OF McDONALD – 2019 STREET RESURFACING PROGRAM**

Sealed bids will be received at the Village of McDonald, 451 Ohio Ave., McDonald, Ohio 44437, up to the hour of 12:00 PM, local time on the 3rd day of April, 2019 and read publicly thereafter, by Village representatives and GPD Group, for the following:

### **VILLAGE OF McDONALD – 2019 STREET RESURFACING PROGRAM**

The project will consist of a base bid and three alternate bids. The base bid will consist of the improvement of 0.31 miles of Grant Avenue (E. 5<sup>th</sup> St. – McKinley Blvd.) by resurfacing. The work will include the reconstruction of the existing roadway cross-slope to improve drainage characteristics, the adjustment or reconstruction of manholes, storm sewer inlets, and water valve boxes, as well as the construction of new curb ramps to meet ADA compliance.

The three alternates will consist of resurfacing and work similar to that in the base bid. The following breakdown is a list of the alternate bids:

Alternate A – E. 3<sup>rd</sup> Street (Ohio Ave. – Grant Ave.) 0.12 Miles

Alternate B – Garfield Ave. (E. 5<sup>th</sup> St. – E. 4<sup>th</sup> St.) 0.11 Miles

Alternate C – McKinley Blvd. (E. 5<sup>th</sup> St. – E. 4<sup>th</sup> St.) 0.11 Miles

The contract documents, including plans and specifications are on file and may be examined by appointment at the following address: Village of McDonald; 451 Ohio Ave., McDonald, OH 44437 or by calling (330)-530-5472. Plans may be obtained upon depositing a check for Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25.00) made payable to the Village of McDonald, which is non-refundable.

Each bidder is required to furnish with its proposal, a Bid Guaranty and Contract Bond in accordance with Section 153.54 of the Ohio Revised Code. Bid security furnished in Bond form, shall be issued by a Surety Company or Corporation licensed in the State of Ohio to provide said surety. Each Proposal must contain the full name of the party or parties submitting the proposal and all persons interested therein. Each bidder must submit evidence of its experiences on projects of similar size and complexity. The owner intends and requires that this project be completed in 45 calendar days from the notice to proceed.

All contractors and subcontractors involved with the project will, to the extent practicable, use Ohio products, materials, services, and labor in the implementation of their project. Additionally, contractor compliance with the equal employment opportunity requirements of Ohio Administrative Code Ch. 123, the Governor's Executive Order of 1972, and the Governor's Executive Order 84-9 shall be required.

Bidders must comply with the prevailing wage rates on Public Improvements in Trumbull County and the Village of McDonald, Ohio as determined by the Ohio Department of Commerce, Bureau of Wage and Hour Administration, 614.644.2239.

No bidder shall be considered a competent and responsible bidder or eligible to be awarded the contract to which this Notice applies, if the bidder is listed on the Auditor of State's database as having a "Finding of Recovery" as that term is defined in O.R.C. 9.24.

Bids shall be submitted on forms provided and shall state the Unit Price or Lump Sum as indicated by the blanks provided therefore; and shall be enclosed in a sealed envelope marked on the outside "2019 Street Resurfacing Program" with the contractor's name, address, phone number, email address and contact name. The Village of McDonald reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive any formalities or irregularities in bidding.
