

**VILLAGE OF McDONALD, OHIO**

**ORDINANCE NO. 3260-21**

**ORDINANCE FOR THE PURPOSE OF AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, FISCAL OFFICER AND/OR VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH KLABEN FORD, 3853 YOUNGSTOWN ROAD, WARREN, OHIO 44484, TO PURCHASE A 2021 POLICE INTERCEPTOR VEHICLE, and declaring an emergency.**

WHEREAS, Council for the Village of McDonald deems it necessary to purchase a new vehicle for the Police Department; and

WHEREAS, Council for the Village of McDonald desires to authorize the purchase a 2021 Police Interceptor vehicle from Klaben Ford at the price of Thirty-Two Thousand Nine Hundred Twenty-Three and 14/100 Dollars (\$32,923.14).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF McDONALD, TRUMBULL COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO, WITH AT LEAST TWO-THIRDS OF THE MEMBERS ELECTED THERETO CONCURRING, that:

Section I. The Mayor, Fiscal Officer, and/or Village Administrator are hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Klaben Ford, 3853 Youngstown Road, Warren, Ohio, 44484, for the purchase of a 2021 Police Interceptor vehicle at the price of Thirty-Two Thousand Nine Hundred Twenty-Three and 14/100 Dollars (\$32,923.14).

Section II. The passage of this Ordinance and all deliberations relating to the passage of this Ordinance were held in open meetings in accordance with the provisions of Ohio Revised Code Section 121.22.

Section III. To preserve the public peace, health, welfare and safety by providing a new and necessary Police Department vehicle to patrol the Village for the safety of the residents, and for the further reason that the order for the vehicle must be placed forthwith to obtain the vehicle at the stated price, this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect and be in full legal force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
