RESOLUTION NO. 1884-23

**RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE BID OF OHIO VALLEY WASTE SERVICE, INC., 1534 MAHONING AVENUE, YOUNGSTOWN, OHIO 44509, FOR THE PERFORMANCE OF THE VILLAGE'S MUNICIPAL SOLID WASTE COLLECTION SERVICES AGREEMENT AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, FISCAL OFFICER, AND/OR VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH OHIO VALLEY WASTE SERVICE, INC., and declaring an emergency.**

WHEREAS, the Village of McDonald solicited competitive bids for the performance of the Village's Municipal Solid Waste Collection Services and has received and publicly read the competitive bids;

WHEREAS, the Village desires to enter into an Agreement with a three-year initial term beginning June 1, 2023 and ending May 31, 2026, with the lowest and best bidder; and

WHEREAS, Council has determined that the bid from Ohio Valley Waste Service, Inc. in the amount of Thirteen and 60/100 Dollars (\$13.60) per residential unit per month for the first year, Fourteen and 00/100 Dollars (\$14.00) per residential unit per month for the second year, and Fourteen and 45/100 Dollars (\$14.45) per residential unit per month for the third year is the lowest and best bid.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF McDONALD, TRUMBULL COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO, WITH AT LEAST TWO-THIRDS OF THE MEMBERS ELECTED THERETO CONCURRING that:

Section I. The bid of Ohio Valley Waste Service, Inc. is the lowest and best bid and Council hereby accepts the bid for the Village's Municipal Solid Waste Collection Services.

Section II. The Mayor, Fiscal Officer, and/or Village Administrator are hereby authorized and directed to execute an Agreement with Ohio Valley Waste Service, Inc. for the performance of the Village's Municipal Solid Waste Collection Services for a three-year initial term beginning June 1, 2023 and ending May 31, 2026. A copy of the Agreement is attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit A.

Section III. The Mayor, Fiscal Officer, and/or Village Administrator are hereby authorized and directed to execute all documents ancillary and necessary to the Agreement.

Section IV. The passage of this Resolution and all deliberations relating to the passage of this Resolution were held in open meetings in accordance with the provisions of Ohio Revised Code Section 121.22.

Section V. To preserve the public peace, health, welfare and safety, and for the specific reason of entering into the Agreement as soon as possible due services under the Agreement beginning on June 1, 2023, this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect and be in full legal force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
