RESOLUTION NO. 1908-24

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND FISCAL OFFICER TO ENTER INTO AN EMERGENY MEDICAL SERVICE AGREEMENT WITH LANE LIFETRANS PARAMEDICS, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, Council for the Village of McDonald deems it prudent for the Village residents to have adequate emergency medical services available;

WHEREAS, although the Village Fire Department provides the Village residents with primary emergency medical services, it is prudent to have in place adequate backup service; and

WHEREAS, Lane LifeTRANS Paramedics has provided the Village Fire Department ambulance service with backup emergency medical services since 2015, and Council desires to continue the Village's relationship with Lane LifeTRANS Paramedics.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF McDONALD, TRUMBULL COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO, TWO-THIRDS OF THE MEMBERS ELECTED THERETO CONCURRING that:

<u>Section I.</u> The Mayor and Fiscal Officer are authorized to enter into an Emergency Medical Services Agreement with Lane LafeTRANS Paramedics for a three (3) year term, commencing on September 4, 2024 and ending on September 3, 2027. A copy of the Agreement is attached hereto.

<u>Section II.</u> The passage of this Resolution and all deliberations relating to the passage of this resolution were held in open meetings in accordance with the provisions of Ohio Revised Code Section 121.22.

<u>Section III.</u> To preserve the public peace, health, welfare and safety, and for the specific reason of assuring the Village has continued ambulance and paramedic backup services in place for the health and safety of the residents of the Village, this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect and be in full legal force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
