RESOLUTION NO. 1923-25

RESOLUTION FOR THE PURPOSE OF AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO EXECUTE AND FILE AN APPLICATION WITH THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES FOR FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FOR PUBLIC RECREATION PURPOSES THROUGH THE RECREATIONAL TRAILS PROGRAM (RTP) AND/OR THE CLEAN OHIO TRAILS FUND (COTF), and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio, through the Ohio Department of Natural Resources, administers financial assistance for public recreation purposes through the Recreational Trails Program (RTP) and/or the Clean Ohio Trails Fund (COTF);

WHEREAS, KO Consulting, LLC has advised Council that there is an opportunity for the Village of McDonald to apply for and potentially receive financial assistance for public recreation purposes through the Recreational Trails Program (RTP) and/or the Clean Ohio Trails Fund (COTF); and

WHEREAS, Council desires to authorize Village Administrator, on behalf of the Village of McDonald, to execute and file an application with the Ohio Department of Natural Resources to receive financial assistance for public recreation purposes through the Recreational Trails Program (RTP).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF McDONALD, TRUMBULL COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO, WITH AT LEAST TWO-THIRDS OF THE MEMBERS ELECTED THERETO CONCURRING, that:

Section I. Council approves the filing of an application with the Ohio Department of Natural Resources for financial assistance for public recreation purposes through the Recreational Trails Program (RTP).

Section II. The Village Administrator is hereby authorized and directed to execute and file such an application with the Ohio Department of Natural Resources and to provide all information and documentation required to become eligible for possible funding assistance.

Section III. Council does agree to obligate the funds required to satisfactorily complete the proposed project and become eligible for reimbursement under the terms and conditions of the Recreational Trails Program (RTP).

Section IV. The passage of this Resolution and all deliberations relating to the passage of this Resolution were held in open meetings in accordance with the provisions of Ohio Revised Code Section 121.22.

Section III. To preserve the public peace, health, welfare and safety, and for the specific reason of timely submitting the aforementioned application with the Ohio Department of Natural Resources, this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect and be in full legal force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
