Join us Mondays at 10 AM at the white gazebo for storytelling with Roosevelt Elementary teachers! Please see the schedule on the back for the teacher lineup.


#### Tuesday: Outdoor Movie Nights

#### Tiedye Day: Wednesday, July 30




