

VILLAGE OF McDONALD, OHIO

RESOLUTION NO. 1943-25

A RESOLUTION ALLOWING THE MAYOR, FISCAL OFFICER, AND/OR VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR, ON BEHALF OF THE VILLAGE OF MCDONALD, OHIO, TO APPLY FOR TRANSPORTATION ALTERNATIVES PROGRAM (TAP) FUNDS PROGRAMMED BY THE EASTGATE REGIONAL COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS (EASTGATE) TO INSTALL THE WEST SECOND STREET SIDEWALK INSTALL PROJECT, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the 2029 West Second Street Sidewalk Install Project is highly important and;

WHEREAS, this improvement is critically needed by the Village of McDonald, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, the 2029 West Second Street Sidewalk Install Project is in need of installation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF McDONALD, COUNTY OF TRUMBULL, STATE OF OHIO, WITH AT LEAST TWO-THIRDS (2/3) OF ITS MEMBERS CONCURRING:

Section I. That the Mayor, Fiscal Officer, and/or Village Administrator are hereby authorized on behalf of the Village of McDonald to apply for Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP) funds programmed by the Eastgate Regional Council of Governments for the following improvement project:

Project Name:	2029 West Second Street Sidewalk Install Project
Project Description:	Installation of sidewalk along West Second Street
Project Termini:	Beginning at the intersection of Ohio Avenue and West Second Street and going west along the north side of Second Street to the intersection of McDonald Avenue.
Estimated Cost:	\$355,570.00

Section II. That the Village of McDonald acknowledges and understands the Eastgate “Funding Policy Guidelines” and confirms, to the best of its knowledge, that the information contained in the project application is accurate, that it intends to diligently pursue that project, and that a local share is required in the amount of \$71,114.00 to match federal funds.

Section III. That the passage of this Resolution and all deliberations relating to the passage of this Resolution were held in open meetings and in accordance with the provisions of Ohio Revised Code Section 121.22.

Section IV. That to preserve the public peace, health, welfare and safety, and for the further reason that the immediate effectiveness of this Resolution is necessary so the Village may timely apply for funding within the next 10 days, this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect and be in full legal force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
