RESOLUTION NO. 1959-26

**RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE BID OF LINDY GROUP, 1807 SHENANGO ROAD, NEW GALILEE, PA 16141 FOR THE 2026 STREET RESURFACING PROGRAM WITH A BASE BID OF ONE HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED SIXTY AND 00/100 DOLLARS (\$169,960.00) AND FOR THE FURTHER PURPOSE OF AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, FISCAL OFFICER, AND/OR VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH LINDY GROUP AND EXECUTE ANY OTHER DOCUMENTS NECESSARY TO FURTHER THE PROJECT, and declaring an emergency.**

WHEREAS, the Village of McDonald, after advertising according to law, has received and publicly read competitive bids for the 2026 Street Resurfacing Program; and

WHEREAS, Council of the Village of McDonald has determined that the bid of Lindy Group was the lowest competent and responsible bid.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF McDONALD, TRUMBULL COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO, WITH AT LEAST TWO-THIRDS OF THE MEMBERS ELECTED THERETO CONCURRING, that;

Section I. The base bid of Lindy Group in the amount of One Hundred Sixty-Nine Thousand Nine Hundred Sixty and 00/100 Dollars (\$169,960.00) for the 2026 Street Resurfacing Program is determined to be the lowest competent and responsible bid, and the same is hereby accepted.

Section II. The Mayor, Fiscal Officer, and/or Village Administrator are hereby authorized and directed to execute a contract for the 2026 Street Resurfacing Program with Lindy Group and all other necessary documents to complete the project, in accordance with the terms of the legal advertisement and bid specifications.

Section III. The passage of this Resolution and all deliberations relating to the passage of this Resolution were held in open meetings and in accordance with the provisions of Ohio Revised Code Section 121.22.

Section IV. To preserve the public peace, health, welfare and safety, and for the further reason that the immediate effectiveness of this Resolution is necessary so the Village promptly award the contact and schedule the work with the paving season at hand, this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect and be in full legal force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
